This photo is students learning about baleen whales. You can see the whale's tail with Mrs. Shefski showing students at the whale's stomach what they should do. The furthest child you can see is 50 feet away which is where the whale's head would be.



Mrs. Sieminski sorts plankton from water as the whale's mouth swallows the students who represent these items!



The hoola hoop represents the whale's stomach. The plankton students pass through the stomach (hula hoop) and on through the whale's digestive system!
